Dr. K. Stephen Suh is currently a scientific director for the Tumor Bank and Genomics Program at the Cancer Center of Hackensack University Medical Center in the state of New Jersey. His interest is biomarker discovery program and development of molecular diagnostic and prognostic assays for multiple human cancer types.

Dr. Suh finished his postdoctoral training and research/staff fellowship at the National Cancer Institute (NCI) from 1998 to 2007. At NCI, he led a team of scientists to discover Chloride Intracellular Channel 4 (CLIC4) as a tumor biomarker and became a world expert in molecular circuitry of CLIC pathways. He was trained in basic science by majoring in molecular and cell biology of tyrosine kinases at the University of Texas, translational science by working with carcinogenesis and xenograft mouse models at the NCI and currently developing expertise in bench-to-bed side clinical science at the medical center.
